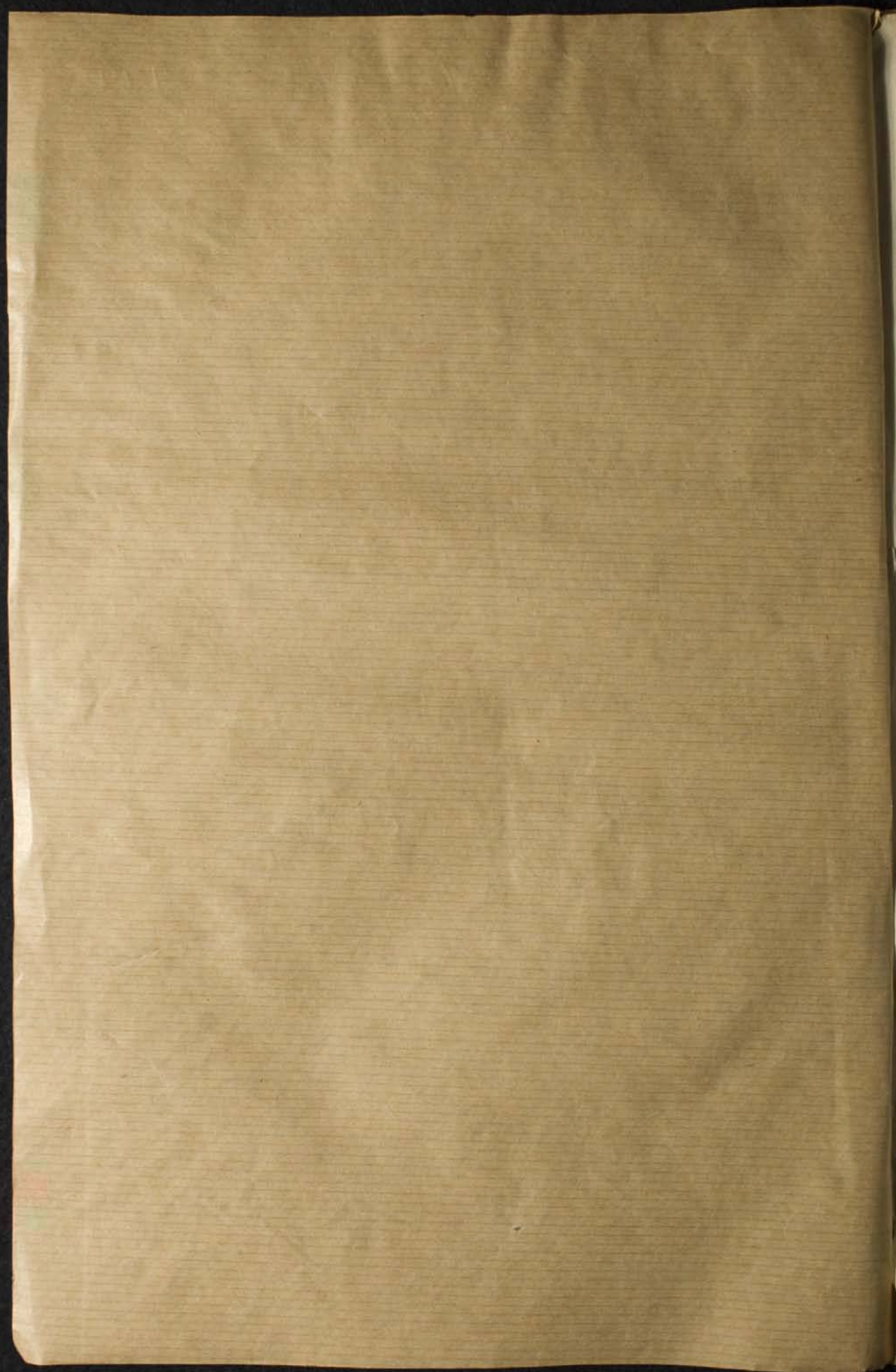

C H A P. V.

WH E R E A S An Act Made in this
Kingdom, in the Ninth Year of the
Reign of His Present Majesty,
Intituled, An Act for the better Regulating of
Juries, hath by Experience been found Use-
ful and Beneficial, and is now Expiring;

Be it Enacted by the King's Most Ex-
cellent Majesty, by and with the Advice
and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and
Tempozal, and Commons in this present
Parliament Assembled, and by the Autho-
rity of the same, That the said Act and
every Clause therein, Save as is hereinaf-
ter Mentioned, Shall be and is hereby

CHAP.
V

Continued to the Twenty Fifth Day of March, which shall be in the Year of Our Lord, One thousand seven hundred and forty four, and from thence to the End of the then next Session of Parliament, and no longer.

Provided nevertheless, and be it Enacted by the Authority aforesaid, That any Person or Persons, Returned on a Jury, who have had the View, may be Challenged for Just Cause; Any Thing in the said former Act, or in this Act to the Contrary in any wise notwithstanding.

Provided also, That no Clause in the said Act, shall Extend to Enable any Judge or Judges of Assize, to order a less Number than Thirty six, or a greater Number than Sixty, on any Venire, to be Returned by any Officer who hath the Return of Juries.

Provided also, And be it Declared and Enacted by the Authority aforesaid, That whensoever it shall happen, that a Jury for the Tryal of any Issue or Issues by Nisi Prius, shall not be Returned by the Sheriff or Sheriffs, but shall be Returned by the Coroner or Coroners, or other Officer or Officers Legally Appointed, that such Coroner or Coroners, Officer or Officers, shall Return the same Number of Jurors, and under the same Qualifications as the Sheriff by Law is Bound to do, and the Jurors so Returned shall be Balloted for in the same manner.
